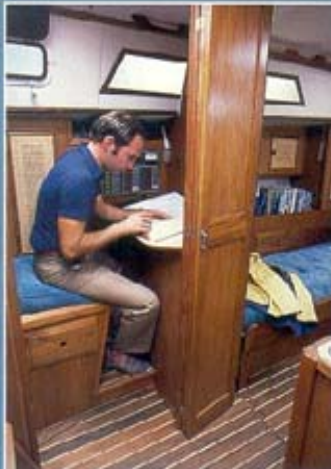


Graves 37

The Graves 37 is a fast ocean cruiser combining state-of-the-art design with a healthy respect for the unchanging dictates of safe seamanship. The interior layout places special emphasis on light, ventilation and a feeling of open space. Three separate cabins provide accommodations for two couples in complete privacy while allowing for three additional crew. The galley is located at the companionway for ready access to the cockpit. There is a complete navigation station and a large head with separate shower stall.

Straightforward design and careful attention to detail in appearance, layout and construction have always set a successful yacht apart. In a design for the 80's, concerns for energy, safety and value make them absolutely essential.

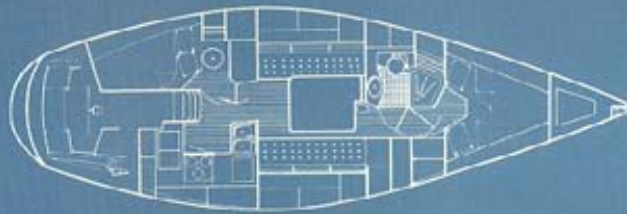
